Welcome to Huron Community Mental Health Services

Mental health concerns, like physical health problems, affect most of us at some point in our lives. Our service supports individuals, age 16 and over, with mental health concerns. It is our goal to help enhance mental health coping skills and improve quality of life.

Our services are available, on a voluntary basis, with priority given to those with serious mental health needs.

The length of involvement with our service depends on individual need.

- The services offered to you will be determined based on information provided at referral, as well as during the initial appointment with a clinician. You and your clinician will develop a plan to address your specific needs and goals.
- Most of our services are provided within a group setting
- Some of the evidence-based groups that may be offered include:
 - Cognitive Behavioural Therapy
 - Dialectical Behavioural Therapy
 - Depression Group
 - Relaxation Group
 - Introduction to Mindfulness
 - Goal Setting Group
 - Social and recreational groups
- Based on severity of illness, limited individual counselling may also be available.
